Good morning,

I would propose the Police budget focus on:

1. Add a new class of officers strictly focussed on traffic violations. These officers do not have to be full police officers, but more like bylaw officers with the power to issue tickets only. This would be a cheaper way to enforce traffic penalties while also maintaining a presence in the community.
2. More focus on school/community contacts with kids. The earlier you can connect with kids, the more likely I believe they will respect Police and the law.
3. Focus on Financial tracking to eliminate drug and gang money. Cyber crime is increasing, and ensure the department has funds and qualified staff to work those cases.
